According to Brown, [redacted] said that she was going to go into the Charter Oak Credit Union in Groton and get him some money. [redacted] gave Brown her pocket book back and handed her a folded note. Brown said she never read the note, [redacted] told her to go to the bank and give the teller the note and leave the purse on the counter. Ponder told her to keep her head down so the cameras don't see her face. [redacted] told her a guy would pick her up in a car and drive her to the bank. She said that he was to tell this guy that she is just going in to cash a check. A four door, bluish car pulled up and a white male driver, medium build and height picked her up and drove her to the Charter Oak Bank on Chicago Ave. in Groton. He pulled up to the side of the bank where the ATM machines are and she proceeded into the bank with her black hand bag and the note. Brown said that she was very nervous and went to a teller and put the handbag down on the counter and handed the teller the note. The teller gave her five, one hundred dollar bills and Brown left the bank. She got back into the car and they drove off. The white male took her to the area of the Burlington Coat Factory where [redacted] was waiting with a drug dealer so they could get more crack cocaine. She gave the drug dealer, described as a black male with Jamaican accent, three hundred dollars for crack and gave [redacted] the other two one hundred dollar bills. [redacted] split the crack with Brown and she left and went to Waterford where she smoked the crack with a friend she chooses not to identify.

Brown stated that she has a crack cocaine addiction and that her life always goes downhill when she is binging on this drug and said that this is why this morning she got into the situation. She knows she was wrong but believes that [redacted] also was involved in this robbery and tricked her into going in with the bomb threat.

The note that the suspect had left with the teller said the following:
"Theres a Bomb in this black bag. Give me 5 100 dollar bills.
And no-one get's hurt. Don't alert anyone or we will all die"

Brown was arrested for the following charges:

- 1. Robbery in the First Degree 53a-134
- 2. Threatening First Degree 53a-61aa
- 3. Breach of Peace First Degree 53a-180aa
- 4. Larceny Fifth Degree 53a-125b

She is being held on a \$250,000.000 bond.
